Real Closet	Most Closets
Mounting system	
Foundation Rails	Hanging Strip
2- foundation rails per partition	1- strip per partition
Mounted below and above partitions	Fits into a notch in the back of partition
Solid Maple with UV finish To match	Metal strip covered with a plastic cover
Foundation Rails	
Floor Mount	
Mounts on <u>top</u> of Foundation Rail	Mounts on <u>top</u> of floor
Clears floor and base moldings	Interferes with flooring and base moldings
Uneven floors don't matter	Must be scribed to fit the floor
Partitions	
3/4" Plywood	5/8" or 3/4" Particle Board
2- foundation metal clips 1-top and 1-bottom	1 -notch in partition to fit over metal strip
2' and 4' tall expandable to 6' and 8' tall	Standard sizes not expandable
High Pressure Melamine Laminate	Low Pressure Melamine
Finished Ends	
Re-usable applied solid maple moldings	Standard partions without holes
"That replicate styles of cabinet doors"	
Shelving	
3/4" Plywood 18", 24" widths	5/8" or 3/4" Particle Board 18"-30" widths
Twin Beam Shelving 18", 24", 35", 47", 59"	NA
Shoe shelf rails are part of the shelf	An additional accessory to purchase
Shelf edge is <u>solid maple</u> with UV finish	1-mill thickness plastic edge banding
High Pressure Melamine Laminate surface	Low Pressure Melamine surface
All clips fit into shelves making them solid	Shelves sit on top of clips loosely and can pull out

Profiled <u>Solid Maple</u> Drawer Fronts	Vinyl Covered Particle Board
Dovetailed prefinished Maple Plywood	Doweled or Stapled Particle Board
Full Extension self centering Glides	3/4 Extension standard Glide
